Peter Styring, Professor of Chemical Engineering & Chemistry at the University of Sheffield



Professor Peter Styring is Professor of Chemical Engineering & Chemistry at the University of Sheffield and Associate Fellow on the Understanding of Politics, a Chartered Engineer and a Chartered Chemist. Peter is now regarded as one of the world experts in Carbon Capture & Utilisation (CCU) with increasing expertise in CCU policy. Professor Styring is currently working on novel solid carbon capture agents combined with solid supported catalysts that can act in tandem and so reduce process costs while increasing energy efficiency.

Professor Styring is an author of the highly influential *Carbon Capture and Utilisation in the Green Economy* policy document that has received global acclaim. He is working with government through consultation on future strategies for CCU both at national and European level.

Professor Styring is also Chair of the CO₂Chem Network, the largest global network of academics, industry and policy makers with interests in CCU.
